Please check the communication folder nightly as your child will periodically have practice to work on at home. There will also be a nightly book buddy bag that will contain a book for your child to read to you come October.

Communication in Kindergarten

Weekly Newsletter

Every Monday, or the first day of the week, there will be a weekly newsletter. Please read this, as it will be full of important dates, reminders, and important updates on our lessons.

Daily Folders

Daily folders will be sent home and have 2 sections: "Return to School" and "Keep at Home". The "Keep at Home" section will have all graded papers or papers completed in class and should be emptied nightly. The "Return to School" section will have papers that need to be completed and returned. Please check your child's backpack nightly for this folder.

Snacks

We will not be having shared snacks again this year, please send an individual snack daily with your child. Please stop by the office and purchase a juice ticket if you would like your child to have milk or juice at snack time. They will be offered white milk, apple juice, and orange juice.

Birthdays

We will celebrate your child's birthday on the day of their birthday if it falls on a school day. If not, we will celebrate a Saturday birthday on the prior Friday and a Sunday birthday on the following Monday. Summer birthdays will be celebrated on a special day in May. Your child is welcome to bring treats to share with their class.

Classroom Behavior

Class rules and expectation will be established with your children to ensure a positive and safe learning environment. Children will learn the importance of respect as well as accepting responsibility for their actions. We do follow the Nurtured Heart approach in the classroom, finding the positive and minimizing the negatives. I understand that 5-6 year olds are learning respect and cooperation, however, there is no tolerance for physical fighting or violence. Your child will be sent home for any physical behavior that is harming others.

Whole Brain

I was blessed to attend a Whole Brain Learning training in Las Vegas. Whole brain is a fun, interactive, and highly engaging way to teach and learn! Information is taught to the students in short "chunks" using a variety of hand gestures in which the students repeat the information and follow along with the gestures. Often, they are then asked to reteach the information to a partner.
